



NOTE:

If the bus has damage that renders it out-of-service, your inspection trooper will need to inspect it after repairs are made and before it is put back in service. If in doubt, ask the trooper!

Attachment A

Your inspection trooper will need **copies** of the following:

- Crash report (generated by the police agency investigating the crash)
- Driver voluntary statement forms
- Student seating chart (if any students were on board at the time of the crash)
- Driver's license
- DOT physical certificate
- Driver certification certificate (blue/yellow card)
- DOE training certificate (observation & driving time)
- Driver drug and alcohol testing (pre-employment, post-accident, or most recent random test conducted within the last 12 months)
- Brake and kingpin inspection sheet
- Any other documents that may assist in the crash review (pictures, other statements or observations, additional driver training (including type of training and date(s) received), etc.)

Attachment B

Your inspection trooper will need **copies** of the following:

- Crash report (generated by the police agency investigating the crash)
- Driver voluntary statement forms

Your inspection trooper will need to **review** the following:

- Driver's license
- DOT physical form
- Driver certification form (blue/yellow card)
- DOE training certificate (observation/driving time)
- Driver drug and alcohol testing (pre-employment, post-accident, or random test conducted within the last 12 months)
- Any other documents that may assist in the crash review (pictures, other statements or observations, records of additional training, etc.)
